## WHO IS IT FOR?

We have room for **up to 40 children** aged **6-12 years** of age and try to have equal numbers of boys and girls.

We have a new system this year for the pastoral care of the singers: Olivia Fyfe, who is now in charge of the arrangements for the weekend. is DBS checked and has experience of child-minding, so it is now possible for children to be left in our care during the daytimes.

We hope, nonetheless, that some parents will wish to be around for the weekend to assist with the feeding arrangements and boost the singing.

We will also have a few 'senior' choristers who will have been to Taste of Morland before and will be able to help the youngest members with singing and general activities.

## WHO RUNS IT?



We will be singing under the expert guidance of **Emma Richardson**. Emma grew up in Wigton, Cumbria before studying Music at the University of Huddersfield followed by training in Secondary Education. She currently teaches at Dowdales School, Dalton-in-Furness. Over the past three years, she has been seconded to the Cumbria Music Education Hub as Area Development Manager for the Furness area, working with large groups of primary students to create performance events at local theatre spaces.

Emma is thoroughly looking forward to returning to Taste of Morland again this year.
