We will also have a few 'senior' choristers who will have been to Taste of Morland before and will be able to help the youngest members with singing and general activities.

We will be singing under the expert guidance of **Emma Richardson**. Emma grew up in Wigton, Cumbria before studying Music at the University of Huddersfield followed by training in Secondary Education. She is currently Subject Leader for Music at Dowdales School, Dalton-in-Furness.
